 pounds in hand paid before the sealing and delivering of these pre-  
 sent, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted  
 Bargain sold Alasd and Confirmed by these presents, doth give grant  
 Bargain sell Alasd and Confirm unto the said Samuel Stuart his  
 heirs and Barnes forever all that tract or parcel of Land laying by  
 being in the County of Chatham and State aforesaid and on the  
 Waters of Little Brush Creek bearing & Recounding as follows, Be-  
 gining at a Hickory on the North side of S. Harden's Improve-  
 ment and running along Thompsons line West one hundred and  
 Eighty three poles to a Hickory on Greves line thence down the stream  
 South fifty three poles to Red Oak at Greves corner then West  
 along his line across said Creek one hundred and Eighty six  
 poles a pine then South two hundred and Sixty nine poles to a  
 post oak then North three hundred and Nine poles to the first  
 Station containing six hundred and forty acres to have and to  
 hold the said Land and premises, with all and singular the appur-  
 tenances, thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and  
 the reversion and reversions, remainder and remenders, rents, issues,  
 and profites therof and every part and parcel therof unto the S.  
 Samuel Stuart his, heirs, and assigns, to the only proper use and  
 behoof of the S. Samuel Stuart his, heirs, and assigns, forever and  
 the S. William Harden for himself and his heirs, do warrant &  
 defend s. Land forever from any person whatsoever being,  
 any just Cleame or titel In Utmost, whereof the S. William  
 Harden hath herunt set his hand and affixed his seal the day
