memory, and wishing to make a disposition of
such property as it has pleased God to bless
me with, do make this my last will and
testament, which I wish to be executed after
my death by my Executor to be hereinafter
named

First. I commit my soul to God who gave it
And request that my body be interred in a Christian
manner —

Second — I will that all my debts be paid
and that my land known by lot 20 in the
Dist of Putnam County and said state be
sold if necessary to pay those debts —

Third I give to my Son Atkinson. S. Hardin
all my negroes (two) Eliza & her child Nina
And all her other increase. Charity, Paul, Nancy
& Easter — All their increase I also give him
All my stock, Kitchen & house hold furniture
and the farm I now live on in Putnam
County and all other property I may hereafter
have at my death

Fourth. I give all the above property to my Son
J. S. Hardin to have at my death after my
debts are paid.

Fifth To my children John, Adam & Heston Hardin
Mary Roberts Linney Sturmon Sarah Spruys
hurs & William Hardin & Benjamin Hardin hurs
I have already given as much property as a reasonable
share would amount to — & therefore I give them
nothing more, but such property as they have secured

I now confirm the gifts to each. —

Lastly - I declare this to be my last ^{full} and testament
- And I do hereby constitute and appoint my son
Othman W. Hardin my executor to convey fully
into effect this my last will —
